November 12, 1939, Phillips Petroleum Company's Santa Fe No. 34, located 1980' from North line and 2200' from East line of Section 28, Township 17-S, Range 35-E, Vacuum Field, Lea County, was drilled to a total depth of 4567'. This well was tubed with 2" USE tubing to 4563'.

After swabbing out the fresh water used to displace the lime dust drilling solution the well started flowing and November 14th on a 9-hour test the well flowed 219 barrels pipe line oil, no water. Gas was not measured.

We wish to ask that this well be given the top allowable for the Vacuum Field effective November 18, 1939.

After we have tested this well further and secured a gas reading we will submit your regular completion report.
