FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

State K # 3 was completed as a flowing well and was produced by natural flow until February 10, 1954 when it was put on the pump. This well has an allowable of 21 BOPD. It is proposed to sand-oil frac this well with 30,000 gallons of lease crude and 30,000 pounds of sand. It is proposed to do this work in three stages of 10,000 gallon of lease crude and 10,000 pounds of sand. Five hundred pounds of moth balls will be injected between stages in an attempt to selectively frac different intervals.

This treatment should result in a top allowable well for this field.
