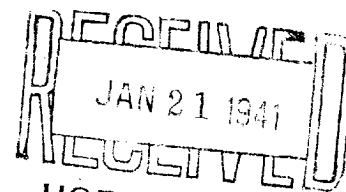


## MISCELLANEOUS NOTICES
