			<p>October 28, 1938 - Authorization SOT Pro-161 received to drill State 4-27 #3 (B-1840 lease) located 1980' from the South and East lines of Section 27, Twp. 17-S, Rg. 35-E, Lea County, New Mexico.</p> <p>Staked location.</p> <p>October 29, 1938 - November 22, 1938, Waiting on rig from State 4-27 #2 well.</p> <p>November 22, 1938 - Started cellar and pits.</p> <p>November 27, 1938 - Finished rigging up and started drilling 17-1/2" hole.</p>

Casing free, circulation good. 15 minutes mixing cement, 10 minutes pumping down plug.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Casing Detail</u></p> <p>237' of 13-3/8", 54.5# and 48#, 8 thd., seamless, second-hand, casing at 254'. Texas Pattern shoe on bottom.</p> <p>November 29, 1938 - After standing cemented 36 hours, casing was tested with 500 psi. Pressure dropped 25 psi in 30 minutes. Casing o.k.</p> <p>Drilled plug and tested WSO with 500 psi. Pressure dropped 40 psi in 30 minutes. WSO o.k.</p> <p>Drilled ahead in 12-1/4" hole</p>
