

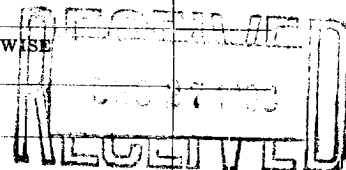

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented 7", 24' casing at 4195' with 330 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement, Haliburton process, Dec. 21, 1938. Stood cemented 72 hours. Tested 7" casing Dec. 24, 1938 with 1000# Hydraulic pressure, let stand 30 minutes- Dropped to 965#. Test O.K. Drilled plug at 4167', drilled and cleaned out cement to bottom of well at 4202'. Tested casing and formation with 1000# Hydraulic pressure. Let stand 30 minutes Dropped to 960# and remained at that point, Test O.K.
