Cemented 7", 24# casing at 4196' with 145 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement, Haliburton process. Let stand 72 hours. Tested 7" casing with 1100# Hydraulic pressure, Let stand 30 minutes, no drop in pressure. Test O.K. Drilled plug at 4166', drilled cement out of casing and cleaned out to bottom at 4201'. Tested casing and formation with 1100# Hydraulic pressure, Let stand 30 minutes, No drop in pressure. Test O.K.
