### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented 9-5/8", 36# casing at 1640' with 615 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement, Haliburton process, Jan. 12, 1939. Let stand 48 hours. Tested 9-5/8" casing, Jan. 14-1939 with 1000# Hydraulic pressure. Let stand 30 minutes, pressure dropped to 975#. Test O.K. Drilled plug at 1615', drilled cement out of casing and cleaned out to bottom at 1645', tested casing and formation with 1000# Hydraulic pressure. Let stand 30 minutes, pressure dropped to 935# and stopped. Test O.K.
