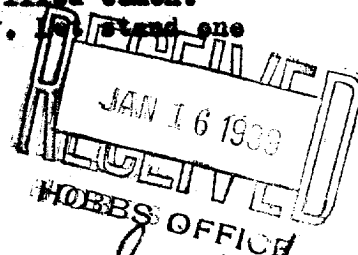

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented 13-3/8", 48# casing at 267' with 250 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement, Haliburton process. Let stand 48 hours. Drilled plug at 250', drilled cement out of casing and cleaned out to bottom at 275'. Bailed well dry. Let stand one hour. Run beller and no fluid had entered the well. Test O.K.
