Acidize formation 4253' to 4644' by removing polish red close tubing at surface, pump 1000 gal. of Gel acid and 5000 gal. of regular acid down 2" by 2" annulus, follow acid with sufficient oil to flush acid into formation.

The above is for the purpose of increasing oil production as the present allowable for this well is 21 barrels per day.
