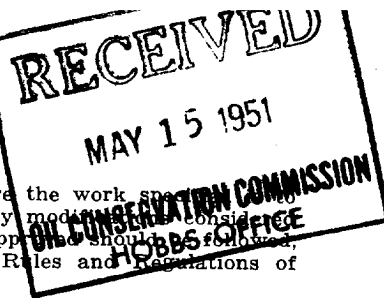

Run bridg plugspot at 4270', fill with gravel to 4265' fill with Galscal to 4250'.
Run 4245' of 5" 15# & flush joint casing cement casing with 250 sacks of cement.
Drill out cement and plug clean out to total depth 4654'.
Run radioactivity log and put well back on production.
