### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized well with 1500 gallons of Dowell XXV<sub>6</sub> acid from 4300' - 4610'.  
Hole was loaded with oil. No packer was used. Formation took acid  
at average pressure of 1500 psi.

Hole was blown dry with high pressure gas after acidizing and allowed  
to stand 5 hours. Well was again blown dry. Well made 2 bbl. of  
fluid, 80% acid water, on the 5-hour test.
