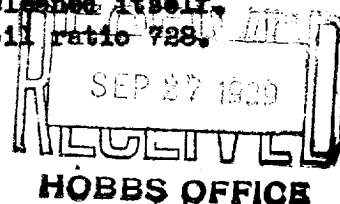

Treated well with 3,000 gallons of Chemical Process Company acid in lime formation from 4360' to 4660'. Swabbed well 6 hrs. Well started flowing & cleaned itself. On 12 hour test well flowed 180 bbls. oil. BS&W 8/10 of 1%. Gas-oil ratio 728. Tubing pressure 30#. Casing pressure 160#.
