### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Loaded hole with oil & treated with 2,000 gallons of Halliburton acid from 4200' to 4660' in lime formation. Reaction time 30 minutes. Flushed with 20 bbls. oil & swabbed well in. Cleaned into pits. Flowed at rate of 26.3 bbls. per hour - 632 bbls. per day - on 3 hour test through 3/4" choke. Daily gas volume 360 M.C.F. Gas-oil ratio 570 to 1. Tubing pressure 55#. Casing pressure 280#. Gravity 37.6 at 60 degrees. BSAW 6/10 of 1%.
