DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4695 Lime. With annular space above packer set at 4070' full of oil, introduced 4500 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 115 bbls. oil. After swabbing out oil load and acid, swabbed 30 bbls. fresh oil, no water in 18 hours. After further swabbing hole caved to 4656'. Cleaned out to bottom and started bailing. Bailed 36 bbls. oil, no water in 18 hours. Continued bailing, recovered approximately 2 bbls. oil per hour. Well was then shut in to run tubing and rods and set pumping unit to produce well on pump.
