## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4695 Lime. Loaded annular space above packer set at 4070' with 120 bbls. oil. Introduced 3000 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 32 hours, recovered oil load & acid & 43 bbls. fresh oil. Next 24 hours swabbed 50 bbls. oil, no water, swabbing off bottom. Next 24 hours swabbed 45 bbls. oil, no water, swabbing off bottom. Well was then shut in to prepare for another acid treatment with 4500 gal. Dowell XXWF-6.
