DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4695 Lime. Pulled tubing & ran in gravel anchor from 4695' to 4685'. Ran in 600 qts. SNG from 4685' to 4343'. Set 24-hour AG time bomb to detonate 3:00 PM January 3rd. Gravel packed hole from 4338' to 3645'. Shot exploded 3:00 PM. Well flowed one large head oil & died. Found top of bridge at 3635'. Cleaned out with drill pipe, circulating oil, to 4680' and hole caved to 4611'. Went in with bailer, cleaned out to bottom. Bailed 1 bbl. oil hourly for 24 hours. Well was then tubed with 2" USE tubing set at 4690', with Guiberson packer set 4070'. Well was then shut in to prepare for acid treatment.
