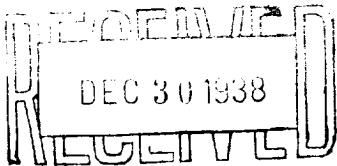

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4629 Lime. Loaded hole with 180 bbls. oil and introduced 3000 gal. Dowell XX. Bled 30 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, treating formation from 4266' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 18 hours, recovering 150 bbls. oil load and acid. Shut well in 30 hours to attempt to pressure up. Opened and well did not flow. Swabbed off bottom 18 hours, recovered 40 bbls. oil load and acid. Well was then shut in to prepare to deepen.
