## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4629 Lime. Loaded hole with 187 bbls. oil & introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XX. Bled 29 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from 4275' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 17 bbls. oil. Swabbed out 150 bbls. oil load and acid in 12 hours, swabbing to approximately 3830'. Next 22 hours swabbed out 45 bbls. oil load and acid, swabbing off bottom. The well was then shut in to prepare for a second treatment with 4000 gal. Dowell XX.
