DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4630 Lime. Loaded hole with 180 bbls. oil and introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XX. Bled 30 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from 4260' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 19 bbls. oil and started swabbing. Swabbed out 305 bbls. oil load, acid and fresh oil in 14 hours. Next 22 hours swabbed off bottom, recovered 144 bbls. fresh oil, no water. Well then started flowing. Flowed 29 bbls. oil, no water in 4 hours. Gas was not measured.
