T. D. 4630 Lime. Loaded hole with 187 bbls. oil & introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XX. Bled 30 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from 4280' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 19 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 16 hours, recovered 205 bbls. oil load and acid. Next 24 hours swabbed off bottom, recovered 170 bbls. oil load, acid & fresh oil.
