DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4700 Lime. Ran in gravel anchor from 4700' to 4678' and placed 590 qts. SNG from 4678' to 4338'. Set AG time bomb to detonate 2:40 PM 12-30-39. Gravel tamped shot with 6- $\frac{1}{2}$ yards from 4334' to 3679'. Shot exploded on schedule. Went in hole with drill pipe & found top of bridge at 3550'. Cleaned out with drill pipe using oil until January 21, 1939. At that time the hole was cleaned out to 4540'. Moved in Cardwell unit and started cleaning out with cable tools, using bailer. Cleaned out to bottom on March 29, 1939. Bailed out 20 bbls. oil, no water in 22 hours and bailed hole dry. Well was then left shut in and preparations were started to tube and acidize.


