DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4645 Lime. With packer set at 4071' and annular space loaded with oil, introduced 5000 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 10 hours, recovered 250 bbls. oil load & acid and well started flowing. Flowed 149 bbls. fresh oil, no water in 7 hours. Circulated 150 bbls. oil and killed well, pulled tubing & packer, reran tubing, swabbed well in and put well on regular production.
