T. D. 4645 Lime. Ran tubing with Ehlor-Dodge hook-wall packer set 4057' & filled annular space above packer with 145 bbls. oil. Introduced 1500 gal. Dowell XXWF-6 acid. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 24 hours, recovered oil load & acid and 62 bbls. fresh oil. Well was then shut in to prepare for a second treatment below the packer.
