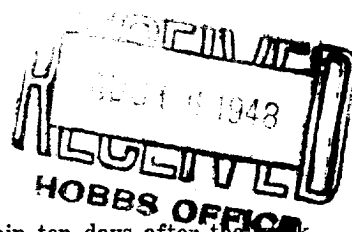

Ran 143 joints, 4409', of 5-1/2" OD casing, set at 4416.42', cemented with 1000 sacks 3% Howeogel. Plug to 4383'. Temperature survey shows top of cement around 5-1/2" casing at 1050'. Tested OD before and after drilling plug.
