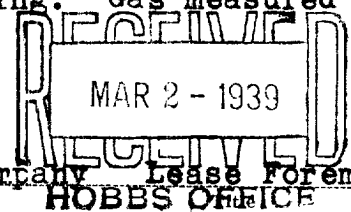

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4667 Lime. With packer set at 4065'10" and annular space above packer loaded with oil, introduced 2500 gal. Dowell XXW-F6. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil, let set 30 minutes & swabbed 4 times off bottom & well started flowing. After recovering 60 bbls. oil & acid the well flowed 199 bbls. fresh oil, no water in 8 hours thru open 2" tubing. Gas measured 537 MCF daily. Gas-Oil Ratio 900.
