FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

In order to increase production we propose to do the following work:

1. Pump well down and inject a mixture of 55 gallons of cheplex in 500 gallons of 5% hydrochloric acid into the tubing-casing annulus.
2. After a period of 24 hours, pull rods and tubing and clean out to total depth.
3. Plug back open hole from 4750' to 4690' (60') with hydromite.
4. Fracture open hole section from 4188' to 4690' with 30,000 gals of refined oil and 30,000 lbs sand in three 10,000 gal stages with 1000 lbs flaked naphthalene between stages down 3" tubing with packer set at approximately 4150'.
5. Recover load oil, Test, return well to production.
