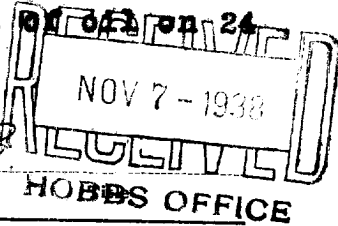

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was treated thru 2 inch tubing set at 4658 feet with 2000 gallons of acid. The lime formation from 4261 feet to 4675 feet was treated and 30 bbls. of oil was pumped after the acid.

As a result of the treatment the well made 125 bbls. of oil on 24 hr. test thru 5/16 in. choke and 50,000 cu. ft. of gas.
