FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

It is proposed to treat Standard's State 3-32 No. 1 Well in the Vacuum Field with 5000 gallons acid. This well is located 1980' from the north and 660' from the west lines of Section 34. The well is presently producing approximately 31 barrels of oil per day, 7,000 cubic feet gas per day and no water. The well was drilled in 1938 to a depth of 4705' and on test at that depth the well produced approximately one barrel of oil and four barrels salt and sulphur water. The well was plugged back to 4647' and the water was completely shut off. 7" casing, the producing string, is set at 4254' and it is proposed to acid treat the open hole 4647' to 4254'. The purpose of the proposed treatment is to increase the production of the well. This well was treated November 1945 with 5,000 gallons for substantial increase in production.

1. The first part of the paper is devoted to the study of the properties of the function $f(x)$ defined by the equation
