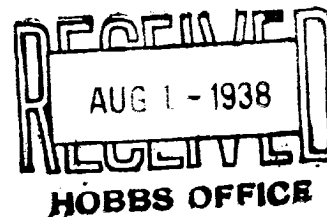
Following is a notice of intention to do certain work as described below at the Standard Oil Company of Texas

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

1. Wash hole from 4400' to 4670' with about 400 gals. Dowell ~~XXW~~ acid.
2. Swab thru 2" tubing for test.
3. Re-run 2" tubing with packer set at 4500' with perforations near bottom of hole to treat formation from 4500' to 4670' with 3000-4000 gals. Dowell ~~XXW~~ acid.
4. If above treatment does not prove satisfactory, acidize formation 4500' to 4500' by re-running 2" tubing and packer, with perforations above packer set about 4490', and treat through perforations.
