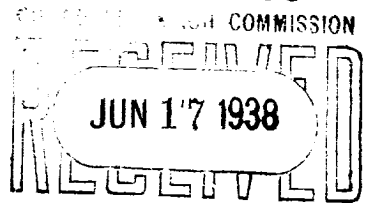

Pressure on 10-3/4" built up to 1200# with water. Stood one hour. Pressure decreased to 1100#.

Drilled 22 feet of cement out of casing and cleaned out 9 feet of cement and cavings below shoe.

Pressure built up on 10-3/4" casing and formation to 1200#. Stood one hour. Pressure decreased to 1090#. Decrease in above pressure was gradual and caused by leak in connections.
