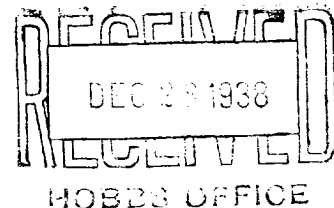

In Notice of Intention to Drill on this well, we showed the 7" casing would be cemented with 330 sacks. The gas made available by our change in plans is to be used for lease and development purposes.
