FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

1. Check the 7" casing with hydraulic pressure using packer and tubing.
2. Spot plug in open hole at approximately 4220'.
3. Run and land 5 1/2" casing at approximately 4205' and cement to the surface.
4. Test 5 1/2" casing with 1500 psi hydraulic pressure.
5. Drill out plugs and cleanout to total depth.

Work is to start approximately July 5, 1955.
