

We wish to put in sufficient cement behind the 7" casing to bring the top of the cement up to 3300', in order to save any gas encountered from 3000' to 3100'. In Notice of Intention to Drill on this well, we showed the 7" casing would be cemented with 330 sacks. The gas made available by our change in plans is to be used for lease and development purposes.
