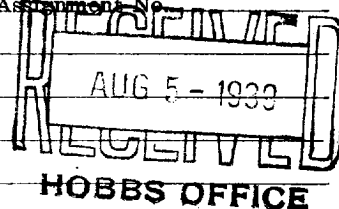

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 4220' feet.

Additional information: The 13" OD casing will be used as conductor pipe, being cemented w/ approx. 25 sx cement. In cementing the 8-5/8" OD casing the cement will be circulated back into casing. In cementing each of the two strings of casing the cement shall be allowed sufficient time to thoroughly set before drilling plug and testing.
