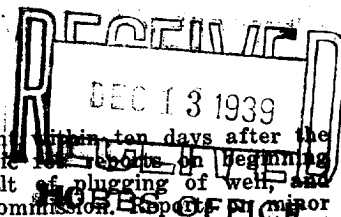

The photo must be taken by a professional photographer. The photo must be submitted with the application form. The passport office will issue the passport if the application is approved. The passport is valid for travel to all countries in the world.
