## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4550 Lime. Loaded hole with 140 bbls. oil and introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XX Bled 30 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from 4200' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Swabbed 3 hours to 3500' and well started flowing. Recovered 180 bbls. oil load and acid during 3 hours swabbing and 4 hours flowing. Tested 6 hours thru 3/4" choke on 2" tubing. Flowed 197 bbls. oil, no water. Tested again 6 hours thru 3/4" choke on tubing. Flowed 178 bbls. oil, no water. Gas measured 317 MCF daily. Gas-Oil ratio 445.
