## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented 13 3/8" - 48# casing at 296' with 250 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement, Haliburton process, Dec. 9, 1938. Stood cemented 48 hours, Tested 13 3/8" casing Dec. 11, 1938 with 550# Hydraulic pressure, let stand 30 minutes - dropped to 500# Test O.K. Drilled plug at 281' and cleaned out cement to bottom of well at 300' Tested casing and formation with 400# hydraulic pressure, let stand 30 minutes Dropped to 300# and remained at that pressure. Test O.K.
