DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented 7", 20# casing at 4201' with 330 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement, Halliburton process, March 11, 1939. Stood cemented 72 hours. Tested 7" casing with 1000# hydraulic pressure. Let stand 30 minutes- no loss in pressure. Test O.K. Drilled plug at 4170', drilled and cleaned out cement to bottom at 4212'. Tested casing and formation with 1000# Hydraulic pressure, let stand 30 minutes- pressure dropped to 960#. Test O.K.
