DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The subject well was treated with 500 gallons of Dowell mud acid to remove the mud cake from the pay zone from 4361 to 4586. No acid was pumped into the formation. The acid was in the hole a total of 1 1/2 hours at which time it was reversed out. Following this acid treatment the well was swabbed for 8 hours recovering 165 barrels of clean oil and no water.
