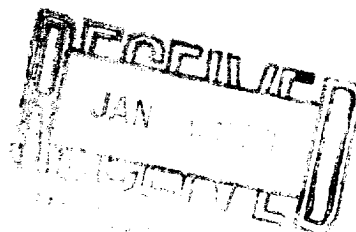

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Subject well was plugged back from 4611' to 4571' with Hydromite to shut off water. The following zones were shot four holes per foot with open-hole jet charges: 4523-17', 4508-03' and 4499-95'. The section 4404-4571' was acidized with 3000 gallons of special low tension acid. On swabbing test, 70.5 barrels of acid water were recovered before swabbing the well dry. There was no show of oil or gas.
