FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

9 5/8" 35# 8rd thd casing was landed and cemented at 1671' with 750 sacks of cement. Approximately 75 sacks of cement were circulated at the surface. The plug was down at 1:53 AM November 29, 1949.

The following procedure is to be followed in testing the 9 5/8" casing for water shut-off:

1. After waiting on cement for 48 hours apply 1000 psi hydraulic pressure to the casing. The test will be considered satisfactory if the pressure drop is less than 100 psi in 30 minutes.
2. Drill out float collar and float shoe and again apply 1000 psi hydraulic pressure for 30 minutes and test as in (1) above.
