9 5/8" casing was landed and cemented at 1671' November 29, 1949.
The casing was tested for water shut-off December 1, 1949, following 48 hours cement time. Testing procedure was as follows:

1. After locating the cement plug at 1597' a hydraulic pressure of 1000 psi was applied. There was no pressure loss in 30 mins.
2. The cement plug was drilled to 1672'. A hydraulic pressure of 1000 psi was applied. There was a pressure loss of 25 psi in 30 minutes.
