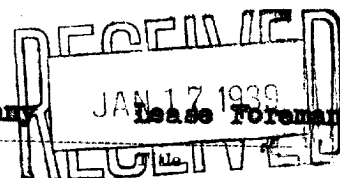

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4687 Lime. Filled hole with gravel to 4628. Shot with 330 qts. SNK from 4628 to 4535. Used 3-1/2 yards gravel tamp, filling hole to 4298. Filled hole with 165 bbls. oil. Found top of bridge 4221. Cleaned out with rotary tools to 4630. Tubed to 4538 with 2" tubing. Swabbed out 185 bbls. oil load & circulating oil. After recovering oil load & circulating oil, swabbed an average of 36 bbls. fresh oil, 0 water, next three days. Will continue testing and possibly shoot again.
