## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4687 lime. Filled hole with gravel to 4628. Shot with 330 qts SNG from 4628 to 4535. Used 3 1/2 yds gravel tamp, filling hole to 4298. Filled hole with 165 bbls oil. Found top of bridge 4281. Cleaned out to 4630 with rotary tools. Tubed to 4538 with 2" tubing. Swabbed out 185 bbls oil load and circulating oil. After recovering oil load & circulating oil, swabbed an average of 36 bbls fresh oil, 0 water, next three days. Will continue testing and possibly shoot again.
