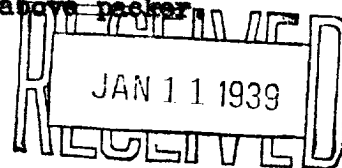

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4687 Lime; Ran tubing with packer set at 4405' to treat dolomite streaks from 4634' to 4670'. Ran 155 bbls. oil down annular space on top of packer. Introduced 1200 gal. Dowell XX. Formation did not take acid. Swabbed acid out and hole was dry with no show gas or oil. Pulled tubing & packer and bailed out oil which was above packer. Preparations were then started to shoot well.
