After drilling a 12-1/4" hole to 3250 feet we ran 101 jts. of new 32 8-5/8" O.D. Casing and cemented at 3245.82 feet with 500 sack 3% gel cement and 300 sack of neat cement. The plug was down at 8:40 AM on October 24, 1950. After waiting 30 hrs. for the cement to harden, the casing shut-off will be tested at 3 PM October 25, 1950.
