DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ " hole was drilled to 366 feet. We ran 9 jts. of 13 3/8" O. D. 48# H-40 new casing which we set at 359.83 feet and cemented with 350 sax cement. Approximately 60 sax of cement were circulated out. The plug was down at 10 AM October 17, 1950. After waiting 24 hours for the cement to harden, the casing was tested with 600 pounds for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure.
