3370' TD Anhydrite, 7 5/8" Casing set at 3367' and cemented with 500 Sax Common and 50 Sax Incor. Ran Temperature Thermometer and top of cement at 2210' outside of 7 5/8" Casing. Picked up 3" drill pipe and found cement plug at 3329', tested Casing with 1000# for 30 minutes and was OK. Drilled out plug and tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes and was OK. Started 6 3/4" hole at 8:30PM April 23, 1946.
