Additional information:

This well has been drilled to a total depth of 4815'. 2" EUE seamless tubing is bottomed @ 4727. Natural, the well swabbed 3 barrels of oil per hour. After a two stage acid treatment of 1000 gallons and 2000 gallons of Halliburton acid, and cleaning up, the well flowed $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours @ daily rate of 594 barrels w/ estimated daily gas rate of 200 Mcft.

Until there is a pipe line gathering system in the field, the oil from this well will be transported by truck to our H.D. Mc Kinley Lease located in section 30-18-38, in the Hobbs field, where two low 500 barrel tanks have been set aside as receiving tanks for the same, and the Atlantic Pipe Line will run the oil from these tanks.

This well is scheduled to go on allowable February 1, 1939.
