DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

@ TD 4315' 5 1/2" OD 17 1/2 Seamless casing was set @ 4624' and cemented w/ 55 sacks of common cement. The well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1200# was applied to the pipe and well head connections, the valves closed and the pressure observed for a period of 30 minutes. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied without a drop in pressure. The hole was cleaned, and preparations made to test well.
